Summary and status within the CRC

Labour policy is essential for social policy and its global dynamics:

- » Functionally, labour and social policy are interrelated (market priority - subsidiary extra-market protection) - it is reflected in the inclusive or exclusive nature of labour policy
- » WeSIS allows comparison between the dynamics and clustering of labour policy as regulatory policy and social transfer systems (A02) and education (A05), family (A06) or migration policy (B04).
- » Accordingly, close cooperation and exchange with these projects as well as with regional experts from all B projects, especially B09 and B10
